Terms of Service for Doctors

Practice area

34. (1) Subject to sub-paragraph (2), a doctor may at any time with the consent of the HA or, on appeal, the Secretary of State, alter the extent of his practice area.
- (2) A doctor shall not, contrary to any condition imposed by the Medical Practices Committee, or on appeal the Secretary of State, under section 33(4) or (5) of the Act, open practice premises in any area or part of an area where, at the time of his application to open such premises, the Medical Practices Committee is of the opinion that the number of medical practitioners undertaking to provide general medical services in that area or part of that area is already adequate.
