### Terms of Service for Doctors

#### *Important Note*

This copy of the NHS (General Medical Services) Regulations 1992 has been electronically reproduced from a version published March 1999 by the GPC secretariat, which was the 1996 consolidated version additionally incorporating seven further statutory instruments (SI).

#### **Records**

36. A doctor shall:

- (a) keep adequate records of the illnesses and treatment of his patients on forms supplied to him for the purpose by the HA; and
- (b) forward such records to the HA on request as soon as possible; and

within 14 days of being informed by the HA, of the death of a person on his list and, in any other case of the death of such a person, not later than one month of learning, of such a death, forward the records relating to that person to the HA.
